1. PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

University of Health and Allied Sciences (UHAS) is pleased to announce the opening of a call for applications for **Student Mobility for Studies** under the Erasmus+ KA171 Programme, in cooperation with Afyonkarahisar Health Sciences University (AFSU).

This mobility supports international exchange between Partner Countries (Ghana) and Programme Countries (Türkiye).

2. KEY MOBILITY DETAILS

Host Institution	Afyonkarahisar Health Sciences University (AFSU), Türkiye
Sending Institution	University of Health and Allied Sciences (UHAS)
Activity Type	Student Mobility for Studies
Duration	Maximum 5 months (Travel days excluded). Minimum duration is 2 months.
Level of Education	1 st cycle – EQF 6
Period	Mobility can be carried out between September, 2026 - February, 2027 (Autumn Semester) or February, 2027 - July, 2027 (Spring Semester) . Mobility dates must be approved by the host institution.
Available Quota	2 (two) participant.
Eligible Departments/Fields	Dental Studies (0911), Medicine (0912), Nursing and Midwifery (0913), Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation (0915), Pharmacy (0916).

3. FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The grant payment will be made during the participant's mobility.

Financial Component	Amount
Monthly Individual Support Grant	€800 per month (for students coming to Türkiye from Non-associated Third Countries).
Travel Grant	€1188 (Standard Travel Grant, for distance band 4000-7999 km).

Financial Component	Amount
Estimated Total Indicative Grant (Per Person)	€5188 (€800 x 5 months + €1188 Travel).
Additional Grant Support	Participants with fewer opportunities are entitled to an additional grant of €250 per month (for student mobility between 2-12 months).

4. APPLICATION EVALUATION CRITERIA (SCORING)

Student applications will be evaluated based on the following selection criteria, as mandated by the Erasmus+ Programme rules:

Academic Achievement Level (GPA/CGPA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must be the criterion with the highest weight among all criteria. ➤ Academic Achievement Level must be at least 58 and above out of 100. 	%60	The primary determinant of ranking.
Foreign Language Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Weight deemed appropriate by the Higher Education Institution. ➤ The Foreign Language score must be at least 50 and above out of 100. 	%40	Must be equally applicable to all students.
Disabled Students	Additional points in an amount deemed appropriate by the institution.	+10	Disability must be documented.
Previous Erasmus+ Mobility	Point reduction may be applied for long-term mobility previously benefited from (study or traineeship).	-10	Reduction is not applied for mobilities in previous education levels.

5. APPLICATION PROCESS AND KEY DATES

- **Announcement Publication:** The call will be announced on the institution's website and notice boards. The announcement must be published at least **20 days (in principle)** before applications begin.
- **Application Submission Period:** Students must be given a minimum of **15 days** to apply.

- **Application Dates: 21/01/2026**

- CV and Motivation Letter.
